All students who were active during the eligibility period outlined below are eligible to receive a grant.

ALLOCATION METHODOLOGY

In considering how funds should be allocated to each student, we have determined that all students have incurred costs and expenses associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. The amount of those costs is roughly equal to the per capita distribution of the student grant funds across each campus, based on the number of eligible students at each location. We have considered whether to require each student to prove an individualized demonstration of need prior to grant disbursement. However, we believe that the time required to conduct such an individualized assessment would be substantial and would cause a significant delay in the delivery of the grants. Given the urgent need among our students for these funds, we have prioritized expediting distribution to the students. With approximately 700 students companywide, our goal is to prevent delays associated with assessing individual student need and instead deliver the funds to students more quickly.

DISTRIBUTION OF GRANTS

Each eligible student and will receive a one-time stipend based on location. The following lists the amounts by location:

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DATE OF DETERMINATION - The student must have been actively enrolled in school during the period of temporary distance education between 3/18/2020 and 5/18/2020, including those students who are currently on a leave of absence, those who completed their program and excluding students who dropped from their program during this same date range.

REPORTING

Documentation for detailed disbursements will be submitted to the Department of Education within 30 days of receipt of the funds and subsequently 45 days thereafter.

Disbursements will be credited to the student's ledger but will not affect the student's tuition balance. Funds may not be used to pay a tuition balance.

POLICY ON STUDENT USE OF FUNDS

- Students may not use the grant funds to pay tuition balances.
- Students may not be asked to use the grant funds to pay for educational supplies.
- Grant funds are to be used for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus, such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care or childcare.
- Each student must sign an acknowledgement that he/she accepted and received the grant funds and that it will be used for its intended purpose.
- Admissions personnel will be instructed that they may not discuss eligibility for CARES Act grants with prospective students. CARES Act grants may not be offered to or discussed with prospective students as an incentive to enroll.

DISBURSEMENT METHOD + STUDENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Checks will be cut for each student and shipped to the location. Each Institute will publish a Grant Pick Up Day where neccessary physical distancing safeguards will be in place. Students will sign the acknowledgement prior to receiving the check, certifying that they will use the funds for the intended purpose of assisting with COVID-19 related expenses.

STAFFING DURING PANDEMIC

To the greatest extent practicable, we are keeping employees on staff. We currently have 13 team members that are on leave and 88 active team members.



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UPDATED 6.12.20

Grant checks were issued to all 676 eligible students on 6/1 and 6/2 and were provided to each Campus for distribution on 6/4 and 6/5. All eligible students were notified of their eligibility via email on 6/8/2020, this also included notification of the grant pickup dates for their campus which occurred between 6/9 - 6/12/2020 and a copy of the Distribution Policy. In order to receive their check each eligible student was required to sign the student acknowledgement form (posted below). As of Friday, 6/12 the following checks were distributed and remaining to be picked up on each campus:
